Overcome your entrepreneurial challenges by learning from the experience of women like you

Professional co-development is a method and a rigorous process that supports **the exchange of practical knowledge** to **improve practices or skills** in a professional **field.** (Payette and Champagne, 1997).

The objectives of professional co-development are as follows:

- > To improve your professional practice
- → To belong to a help group in which you feel supported
- > To develop your interpersonal skills and your capacity to help and be helped

Participants will ultimately be able to draw on the momentum of the group to take action.



### Values

One fundamental rule: **confidentiality** is mandatory; it allows participants to engage in the process authentically.

Our guiding values are commitment, mutual help, and respect towards all members of the group. Each group member signs a code of conduct in advance of the first meeting.

#### Method

Each group member assumes the role of the client for one session while the rest of the group focuses on the problem situation by assuming the role of consultant.

- > Client: The group spends one hour focusing on the client's problem solution.
- > **Consultants:** Consultants share their experience, their thoughts, their recommended solutions to deal with the problem situation, including opportunities to learn from others' experience.
- > Facilitator: The facilitator ensures the session runs smoothly and frames the discussion.



#### Our professional co-development cohorts

When you join one of the Agricultrices du Québec's professional co-development cohorts, you commit to attending the five meetings: an initial icebreaker meeting (1½ hours), followed by four professional co-development meetings with two clients each (2½ hours).

Each group is made up of 6 to 10 women farmers and does not change once the meetings get under way.
